### Immigration Services

US Department of Justice accredited case managers provide civil legal assistance that is recognized by the Department of Homeland Security.

Services are available in both English and Spanish.

- Immigration Legal Assistance Services — Assists consumers with the completion of immigration petitions and the translation of documents. Provides immigration information and referrals.
- English as a Second Language (ESL) Classes — In collaboration with St. Francis Community Center, these classes help non-English speaking immigrants with English language skills.
- Educational/Enrichment Services — In partnership with other county and communities agencies, consumers can take part educational services, which can include parenting or GED classes.
