Senior Case Management Services Program

The Senior Case Management Services (SCMS) program uses a housing-first model to serve residents 55 or older who are homeless or at risk of homelessness because of substance abuse, mental illness or both. Case managers work with the staff at the Trenton/Mercer Coordinated Entry and Assessment System (CEAS) Center to increase housing stability by providing psycho-educational resources and referrals to medical, mental health and/or substance use services.

► For My Baby and Me

Integrated substance use treatment program for pregnant women and new mothers provided through the collaboration of Catholic Charities, Capital Health, Henry J. Austin Health Center, HomeFront, Rescue Mission of Trenton and Trenton Health Team. For My Baby and Me offers immediate access to treatment as well as a range of support services to help women achieve long-term recovery. Medication-assisted treatment is available. Peer Support Staff are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

► Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP)

IOP provides structured, evidence-based substance use treatment for adults requiring more support than traditional outpatient care but who do not need 24-hour supervision. The program offers a comprehensive range of services, including individual therapy, group counseling, family support sessions, and psychoeducation focused on relapse prevention, coping skills, and recovery planning. Psychiatric evaluations and medication management are available for individuals with co-occurring mental health disorders. Treatment is tailored to each participant's needs, promoting long-term recovery, improved functioning, and enhanced quality of life in a supportive, community-based setting.

Through age-appropriate, evidence-based interventions, participants engage in structured group and individual counseling that emphasizes early identification of risk factors, coping strategies, and the development of resilience. Prevention education is woven throughout the program, focusing on the long-term impact of substance use on brain development, academic achievement, relationships, and mental health. Peer support and coordination with schools and community resources are also integral to our model, fostering a holistic and sustainable approach to substance use prevention.
