## Domestic Violence Services of Burlington County

Providence House Domestic Violence Services seeks to end the cycle of domestic violence through education, empowerment, and advocacy while providing a safe haven from abuse. We provide comprehensive services to educate and empower survivors of domestic abuse and their children to make the life-altering changes that lead to violence-free lives.

Providence House seeks to remove the barriers that prevent a survivor of domestic violence from living an abuse-free life. These barriers are often created by the lack of knowledge about domestic violence, unstable financial and housing resources, fear for one's safety, social isolation and/or low self-esteem. Providence House empowers survivors to break down the barriers and to make life-altering changes, assisting with safety planning, understanding the restraining order process, learning about the dynamics of abuse, and becoming aware of their options.

These services are **FREE OF CHARGE** and are invaluable to survivors and their children who are struggling to break free from the abuse in their lives.

### OUR FREE AND CONFIDENTIAL SERVICES INCLUDE:

**24-Hour Domestic Violence Hotline** — For survivors and their children in need of crisis counseling and/or a safe haven from abuse, as well as information, appointments and referrals.

**Emergency Safe House** — Confidentially located emergency Safe House that enables survivors and their children to escape danger and to begin the healing process.

**Domestic Violence Education Group** — Provides multi-week education sessions on the dynamics of abuse, including power and control, boundaries, self-esteem and healthy relationships.

**Open Support Group** — An empowerment based, trauma-informed model designed to address the emotional needs of survivors of domestic violence.

**Legal Advocacy Program** — Offers court accompaniment and support to survivors, as well as advocacy and referrals.

**Intensive Case Management** — Advocacy and case management services tailored to identifying and addressing barriers to maintaining long-term housing and creating an abuse-free life.

**PALS (Peace: A Learned Solution)** — Helps children ages 3-12 who have been exposed to domestic violence to heal through various forms of creative arts therapies.

**Domestic Violence Response Team** — Provides training, supervision, and guidance to teams of community volunteers who speak to survivors at the local police station or hospital immediately following a domestic violence incident.

**Domestic Violence Liaison Program** — Provides on-site case consultation, support and advocacy at area Division of Child Protection and Permanency offices for non-offending parents who are experiencing domestic violence.

**Community Education** — Encourages prevention and promotes awareness of the forms of domestic abuse through presentations at health fairs, businesses, schools, community events and organizations.
